











Line-of-Sight (LOS) Rehabilitation



- Runway 14L/32R
 - Remove Hump from Runway
- AIP/FAA Grant Funded
- Project Area 1,000 ft x 4,500 ft
- Replacement of Lighting Full length
- Set to Begin Fall
 2019 and Conclude
 2020

Industrial Wastewater




- Addition of Sec 19 (640 Acres)

Road G Project (Westside Employment Center)

- 2,100 Acres of Undeveloped Land
 - 1,388 Acres Public (66%)
 - 1,257 Acres Port Owned (60%)
 - 698 Acres Private (34%)
- Formation of an LID to Facilitate Infrastructure Development
 - 53% of Private Ownership Approve
 - Formation of LID Approved by Port Commission March 11th 2019
- Project Includes
 - Entrance to Highway 17
 - 3 ½ Miles of Road Bed
 - Water, Sewer and IWW
 - Resolve Power Needs







Planning for the Future

Northern Columbia Basin Rail (NCBR) Project

- Construction of 8 Miles New Track
- Rehabilitation of 3 Miles Existing Track
- 20 mil in State Funding
- 10 mil in Federal Funding
 - Federal Obligation Fall 2019
- Construction to Begin Spring 2021 and Conclude In 2022
