In 2013, the Legislature amended RCW 50.12.070, and subsection (2)(c) was removed from the statute. The substance of RCW 50.12.070(2)(c) was moved to subsection (2)(b). Thus, the cross-reference in WAC 192-220-070 should be updated to reference RCW 50.12.070(2)(b). Reasons supporting proposal: The proposal is needed to update WAC 192-220-070 so that it references the correct subsection in RCW 50.12.070.
