Agency: Employment Security Department

Subject of possible rule making: The Employment Security Department is engaging in rulemaking regarding the declaration and ending of public health emergencies during a benefit week.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 50.12.010 and RCW 50.12.040 provide general rulemaking authority to the Employment Security Department. RCW 50.20.010 defines benefit eligibility conditions for unemployment benefits.

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:

Currently, multiple factors for determining a claimant's eligibility for unemployment benefits are impacted by a declaration of a public health emergency. The Department intends to adopt rules to clarify whether a claim is covered by a public health emergency declaration when the public health emergency is enacted or lifted during a benefit week.

Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies: The U.S. Department of Labor reviews the state's administration of the unemployment insurance program to ensure conformity to federal statutes and regulations. The state has broad flexibility in the implementation of the unemployment insurance laws so long as conformity is maintained. The proposed regulations will be shared with USDOL prior to adoption.
