The enacting legislation requires that applications be submitted by September 30, 2020 (Engrossed House Bill 2965 (Laws of 2020, ch. 7), Sec. 5(1)). The effective immediate date provides employers with the maximum amount of time to submit applications prior to the statutory deadline.
Purpose: In the 2020 Regular-Session, the Legislature passed Engrossed House Bill 2965 (Laws of 2020, ch. 7), codified as RCW 50.29100, which, among other things, creates a COVID-19 unemployment account and appropriates funds into the account for the purposes of reducing specified benefit charges to eligible employers. Rules are necessary in order to establish which employers are eligible to apply for benefit charge reduction, which benefit charges are eligible to be reduced, and the process for how employers can apply for benefit charge reduction.
