| <b>Purpose:</b> The Employment Security Department is adopting emergency rules to provide flexibility and relief to claimants and employers who are impacted by the wildfires in Washington and other disasters. These rules address the requirements that an unemployed individual be able and available for work and the requirement that individuals make satisfactory progress in their training to receive training benefits.
