Purpose: This rulemaking is necessary to amend current rules in accordance with the Department's 2022 legislative report on transportation network companies and to integrate transportation network companies and their drivers into the unemployment insurance system as set forth in SHB 1570 (2023). Transportation network companies are required to submit quarterly reports to the Department that include the total hours worked by each driver, in accordance with RCW 50.12.070. This rulemaking will set forth the method for transportation network companies to calculate and report hours worked by drivers in their quarterly reports to the Department.
